I am excited to see how the project develops

I come from Berlin, Germany and have been to Mother's Heart Uganda in the rural community of Mutoto for just a few days now, but I have already noticed the tremendous effect that the project has on this rural community, due to Jeremiah's and Kate's passion for it. I have noticed that children no longer have to walk several kilometers to the nearby schools but instead they have close access to Golden Hill Academy and not only get an education but also some lunch and recently even got the vaccinations for children against Polio, Measles and Rubella. Community awareness about HIV/AIDS is done and other health issues through community outreaches. On my first day at the school I learnt that in 2018 they had supported Peter who is in kindergarten , aged five, from Mutoto village that was born blind, but funds were mobilized and the boy was able to get the eye surgery that enabled him to get his sight back, now he sees! Not only does this simplify his life and increases his opportunities in life, but it also lifts a weight off of his parents shoulders, who used to have to walk him to school every day.

Women empowerment still has a long way to go here in the community, which is why Kate is mentoring several girls and teaching different courses on handcrafting which now acts a source of income for the women and the project for its sustainability.

Nonetheless, the problems in the community like poverty, high levels of illiteracy , maternal and child death, poor roads, nutrition and hygiene related illnesses and water born illnesses are still rampant in this community. Unfortunately the rainy season began and when it rains heavily kids miss an entire day or several hours of school and some get sick. A lot of them can be seen on the streets in shorts and with bare feet, in the cold mud, coughing. As you can see there are several problems which have been solved through the work of Jeremiah and Kate, but a lot of problems still remain to be solved, which is why I am excited to see how the project develops during my stay here in Mother's Heart Uganda.

needs money elsewhere. It was remarkable to see so much get done so quickly. It doesn't mean they are perfect.


